Secretary Manager and Chief Grossman continue to meet with the site creator to update and learn the new program.

#### 4.3 Old To New Hall transition plans

Trustee Mellson reported that he received an email from the moving company confirming that they would be able to do the move as requested. They stated that they would be able to do the whole move in 1 day. Estimated cost \$3217.14

#### 5.1 Finance Reports

The Financial reports were circulated and reviewed.

The GST was submitted with an estimated return of \$219,000.00. This is largely due to the building of the new hall.

The second payment from the Province has been deposited. The funds have been put into cashable term deposits to coincide with the building project.

Cowichan Tribes has been billed for this year. Billing is based on units to protect as well as a portion of the Cowichan Bay Improvement yearly budget.

## 5.2 Fire Chief Report

The Fire Chief report was circulated prior to the meeting. The Chief reported that the department has responded to 101 calls to date this year.

There are 28 members, with 30% average responding to the calls.

The department has a contract to be on wildfire call every second week within the area of the Malahat to Nanaimo. One truck and crew of 3 is on stand by during the on call week.

The department received cooling wraps from a resident to help the members stay cool during the heat of training or fires. The department sent a thank you to the resident.

The fire department has reuseable shopping bags, that were created and given to the hall to distribute with local advertising on them. These will be handed out at community events.

## 5.4 Trustee's Report

Trustee Huebner reported that a 360 review was being conducted to be distributed and completed by the fire chief and crew. The survey is to help aid in the smooth running of the department.
